

Admissions Policy and Tuition Fees at the Nazareth High School of Warsaw

I. General Regulations

1. The School accepts candidates who are open to Christian values and consciously choose the Catholic way of formation as well as agree to obey the regulations stated in the School's Charter.
2. The application is based on an interview with the Candidate and her parents and the Candidate's results from the previous school year.
3. The date of the interview is scheduled by the Candidate's parents in the School secretariat.
4. Students from outside Warsaw are guaranteed a place in the boarding house.

II. Required Documents

1. A completed copy of the applicable questionnaire (pre-IB, IB 1)
2. A record of grades from the first semester/second trimester of the preceding school year, certified with a school stamp
3. The original certificate from the previous school year (after the end of the school year)
4. FCE / CAE certificate (if applicable)
5. Birth certificate
6. An identity document (e.g. passport copy)
7. A specialist opinion on special educational needs (if applicable)
8. 4 current photographs, signed on the reverse side
9. Signed 'Fees and tuition policy' document
10. For candidates, whose parents are not current inhabitants of Poland, a document confirming the legal guardianship by a third party, who is a resident of Poland

III. Conditions for Accepting Students

1. Conditions for accepting students into the pre-IB class (years 1 and 2 of High School)

1. Positive outcome of the interview in which the Candidate presents her interests, achievements, social activities and motivation for choosing Nazareth High School.
2. An interview of the Candidate's parents/legal guardians with the Headmistress (students from abroad are required to have a legal guardian who is a current resident in Poland; the guardianship must be confirmed by a notary).
3. Good mid-term/final grades in the previous school year as well as at least a very good grade for conduct.
4. Passing an entrance test in English (or possessing a B2 certificate in English, such as FCE) and in Mathematics.
5. Paying the pre-IB entry exam fee (300 zł)
6. Paying the entry fee (2990 zł) (after initial acceptance into the school).

2. Conditions for accepting students from other schools into IB 1 class (year 3 of High School)

1. Positive outcome of the interview in which the Candidate presents her interests, achievements, social activities and motivation for choosing Nazareth High School.
2. An interview of the Candidate's parents/legal guardians with the Headmistress (students from abroad are required to have a legal guardian who is a current resident in Poland; the guardianship must be confirmed by a notary).
3. Good mid-term/final grades in the previous school year as well as at least a very good grade for conduct.
4. Choosing 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL).

While choosing HL subjects, it is only possible to take two from the following at the same time: *biology, chemistry, physics* and *mathematics*

5. Scoring at least 50% in an English C1 level entrance test (or possessing a C1 certificate in English, such as CAE).

6. Passing entrance examinations in:

- subjects selected at Higher Level,
- foreign languages other than English (French, German) at Standard Level and Higher Level,
- mathematics analysis and approaches at Standard Level and Higher Level,
- English A: language and literature at Standard Level and Higher Level,

by candidates who have selected these subjects.

7. Paying the IB exam fee (500 zł)

8. Paying the entry fee (3700 zł)

8. Paying accreditation fee (3500 zł) (after initial acceptance into the school)

3. Conditions for accepting students who completed pre-IB classes at Nazareth High School into IB 1 class (year 3 of High School)

1. At least very good grade for conduct and good final grades in all subjects.

2. Choosing 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL)

While choosing HL subjects, it is only possible to take two from the following at the same time: *biology, chemistry, physics* and *mathematics*

3. Scoring at least 50% in an English C1 level entrance test (or possessing a C1 certificate in English, such as CAE).

4. Passing entrance examinations in:

- subjects selected at Higher Level,
- foreign languages other than English (French, German) at Standard Level and Higher Level,
- mathematics analysis and approaches at Standard Level and Higher Level,
- English A: language and literature at Standard Level and Higher Level,

by candidates who have selected these subjects.

5. Scoring at least a good semi-final grade in an HL subject in pre-IB 2 and receiving a recommendation from the teacher exempts a student from having to take the entrance exam in the given subject, as described in points 3 and 4.

6. Affirmation by the IB staff

7. Paying accreditation fee (3500 zł)

IV. Tuition fees

Tuition at Nazareth High School is payable.

Individual fees:

- entry fee – pre-IB 2990 zł, IB – 3700 zł
- pre-IB exam fee for students from outside our school – 300 zł
- IB exam fee for students from outside our school – 500 zł
- accreditation fee (upon entering the IB programme) – 3500 zł
- examination fees (in October of the final year) – 4 000 zł
- boarding house entrance fee – 1100 zł triple room, 1200 zł double room, 1700 zł single room

Tuition fees (yearly):

- pre-IB (year one and two) – 35 640 zł (3240 zł x 11 months OR 3564 zł x 10 months)
- IB (year three and four) – 43 450 zł (3950 zł x 11 months OR 4345 zł x 10 months)
- boarding house
 - 11 000 zł triple room (1100 zł x 10 months)
 - 12 000 zł double room (1200 zł x 10 months)

– 17 000 zł single room* (1700 zł x 10 months)

*the number of places is limited

Tuition fees include:

- tuition of obligatory subjects in accordance with the Polish National Ministry of Education
- tuition in the IB DP classes in accordance with the requirements set out by the IB
- extracurricular classes led by school teachers
- psychological and pedagogical support
- medical care provided by the school nurse/physician

Tuition fees do not include:

- insurance against accidents
- registration for the IB DP examinations
- extra language courses at school
- external language examinations
- course books and other materials
- uniform
- school trips, visits to museums/theaters, retreat days
- public transport
- catering
